

Background Information

Surveys show that residents consider the village a beautiful, scenic place to live, with a wonderful community. A major negative is the traffic and its impact on our lives, i.e. accidents, noise, access difficulties, pollution, vibrations, and property damage.

In 2024, £400k was set aside by Surrey County Council (SCC) for improvements; a well-fought campaign for average speed cameras (which continues) has been dismissed by SCC in favour of the scheme below. See www.cameras4compton.com for further information, including video footage.
